MAIA Simulated Data Products

The MAIA Simulated Data Products are generated using the pre-launch versions of product generation software. These products are made available to MAIA Early Adopters, with the goal of facilitating the use of actual MAIA data and enabling them to develop code, tools, or procedures needed to integrate MAIA data into their workflow. Early Adopters can also provide feedback on the accessibility and usability of the MAIA data, including comments on data formats, content, compatibility with available tools, or other inputs that they would like the MAIA project to take into consideration.

NOTE: The MAIA Simulated Data Products are generated using combinations of existing remote sensing data, chemical transport model output, and/or surface monitor data, and consistency of content across all data product levels is not guaranteed. Their primary utility is to provide familiarity with data fields, formats, interpretation of fill values, etc., and they are not intended to be used in scientific publications, operational decisions, or any other official use. If you have an idea for other uses of the Simulated Data Products, please discuss your idea with the MAIA team to ensure you fully understand the performance and limitations of the products.

Benefits to participants:

- You will receive access to the latest version of the MAIA Simulated Data Products
- You will be added to a discussion group with all MAIA Early Adopters and MAIA applications group members to discuss the mission and MAIA Simulated Data Products on-demand
- You will be invited to MAIA Early Adopter workshops and training sessions in order to learn about mission progress, target areas, and Simulated Data Products
- You will be invited to present on your intended use of MAIA data and/or use of the Simulated Data Products at MAIA Early Adopter workshops
- Once MAIA has launched, you will receive updates on the progress of regular data product production and be invited to the short courses, workshops, and tutorials organized by the MAIA team

Expectations of participants:

- You will attend (in person or via remote access) at least one MAIA Early Adopters workshop to provide feedback on the Simulated Data Products
- You will provide one slide summaries of your use of the MAIA Simulated Data Products/intended use of MAIA data twice a year to support reporting on the MAIA Early Adopters Program to NASA Headquarters
- You will be available to answer questions from the MAIA team on your intended use of MAIA data, in order for the MAIA team to better understand your needs
- You will not use the MAIA Simulated Data Products in publications or decisional contexts
